

CONSTITUTIVE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

- ✓ On 28 March 2007, 45 companies join forces to create a new international not-for-profit association as the first step to create a European public-private partnership – a Joint Technology Initiative (JTI) - for fuel cells and hydrogen
- ✓ Those 45 companies, among which 12 Small and Micro companies, represent the major share of Europe's hydrogen and fuel cells industry
- ✓ This association, called the JTI Industry Grouping, will be the key interlocutor and partner of the European Commission to create the JTI for fuel cells and hydrogen

STRUCTURE OF THE JTI IG



1. The chairs of the committees will be the board members of the Industry Grouping.
2. The six board members will automatically act as industry representatives in the JTI governing board.
